Each division is \$35 for the year

Open Shows the meet the following criteria:

- 1) Carded Judge
- 2) Standardized Pattern (Ranch Horse/Reining/Ranch Reining)
- 3) Pattern meeting Standardized Requirements (Ranch Trail)

CLASSES

Ranch Riding (Standard Association Patterns including ARHA Ranchmanship Patterns)
Ranch Rail Pleasure
Ranch Reining
Ranch Trail (must include minimum Association Requirements)
Conformation

REGIONS

There will be 6 regions - See Regional Map
Exhibitors may show outside their region with points counting towards awards.

POINT CALCULATIONS

Points will be calculated per class based on the number of entries - See WRHA Rulebook
Highest 5 classes will be counted towards year end High Point
IF there is a tie... class number 6 will be used as tiebreaker and will continue on until the tie has been broken.

TOTAL of all points accumulated, regardless of the location will be credited to the region in which the exhibitor resides.

DIVISIONS

The following divisions will be offered in each of the classes

- 2) Amateur
- 3) Novice Amateur
- 4) Youth 18 & Under
- 5) Youth 18 & Under W/T
- 6) Youth 11 & Under W/T
- 7) Green Mule
- 8) Open Mule
- 9) Amateur Mule
- 10) Youth Mule
- 11) Color Horse (Must have a WRHA Color Card on File)
- 12) Conformation will have the following
 - 1) Mare
 - 2) Gelding
 - 3) Stallion

TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR SHOWS/POINTS

- 1) Association Shows:
 - a) Turn in Show Report with a copy of results page
- 2) Open Show
 - a) Turn In Show Report
 - b) Verification of Carded Judge
 - c) Results Verification signed by Show Secretary
 - d) Copy of Pattern - must have basic required maneuvers

YEAR END PRIZES
